Salt Lake County Caregivers,

Aging & Adult Services offers a Caregiver Support Program that assists family and other non-paid caregivers with:

- Information, consultations, and resources
- Free classes, events, and support groups
- Limited respite services—a brief period of relief for the caregiver (requires an intake/ application)

To participate in the limited respite portion of the Caregiver Support Program, caregivers must be:

- 18 years or older caring for an individual 60 years or older who needs help with at least two activities of daily living
- 18 years or older caring for an individual with Alzheimer's/Dementia of any age
- Older relatives (not parents) age 55 and older caring for children under the age of 18
- Other relatives (including parents) age 55 and older providing care for adults 18 to 59 with disabilities
