



VOTER PRE-REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Thank you for pre-registering to vote in Utah. The State of Utah allows a pre-registered voter who is 17 years of age to vote in a primary election, providing that he/she turns 18 by the date of the General Election in November. Therefore, you will be eligible to vote in the 2019 Election.

Salt Lake County conducts elections mainly by mail. Ballots are mailed to all eligible registered voters three weeks prior to Election Day.

By law, voter records are public information. If you would like us to classify your voter record as private, notify the Election Division by mail or email. If you move from your current address or need to add a mailing address, please complete a new voter registration form online at www.vote.utah.gov. Registration forms can also be submitted to the Salt Lake County Election Division by mail or in person.
