DA's Office Will Not File Charges in Contaminated Tea Incident

Salt Lake City, UT -- Today, the Salt Lake County Attorney's Office announced they will not file criminal charges relating to the recent incident at Dickie's BBQ restaurant in which a customer was injured after drinking tea contaminated with an industrial cleaner. After reviewing an extensive investigation by the South Jordan Police Department, prosecutors determined there is no evidence of criminal wrongdoing. Accordingly, prosecutors have declined to file a criminal charge and have closed their involvement in the case.
