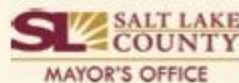

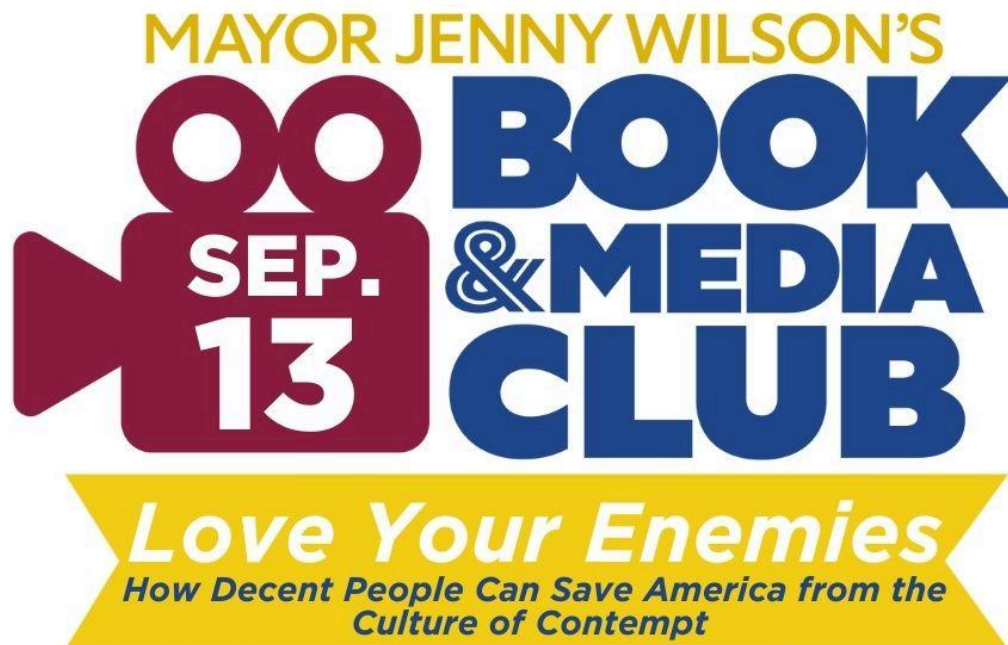
Love Your Enemies
