00:00 Welcome from Chair Sheriff Rivera

Mayor Silvestrini made a motion to approve the CJAC minutes from the October 2023 and January 2024 meeting. Chief Dumont seconded the motion, all were in favor.

01:07 Disclosure Statements

CJAC Attorney reviewed disclosure statements with committee, and reviewed required annual ethics training with group. CJAC Committee members were informed about the need for disclosure statements being renewed each year.

10:10 Crisis Response Presentation

Allison Heffernan presented on the current status of crisis response amongst law enforcement. Reviewed best practices nationwide as well as gaps and barriers law enforcement may be facing when responding to crises in Salt Lake County. Discussion occurred around the room about current resources available and needs for staff and funding.

36:56 **CJAC Work Group Proposal**

Alexandra Allen presented on CJAC Work Groups Historically and focus projects of each. She also presented and proposed two new CJAC Work Groups to be added, Reentry and Reintegration Work Group and Community Crisis Work Group.

Rich Mauro made a motion to approve the two new work groups proposed, Mayor Silvestrini seconded the motion, all were in favor. The two new work groups will become active.

51:02 Legislative Update

Rich Mauro and Will Carlson presented on 2024 legislative updates that affect the work of those in CJAC and the criminal justice system. This included House Bills that increase penalties, new criminal offenses, a bill to reduce penalties, and other House Bills and Joint Resolutions.

1:25:12 Member Round Table and Public Comment

CJAC members were given the opportunity to bring up additional topics, comments, questions or concerns. The room was opened to all attended in person and online. Sheriff Rivera commented on findings from the Major County Sheriff's Conference and to be aware of fentanyl and other dangerous drugs that may be causing increased overdoses in the US. Chief Dumont brought up House bill 335 regarding state funded grants. This bill changes eligibility for state grants, making 1st and 2nd class counties ineligible to receive this funding.
