- 00:00 **Welcome from Sheriff Rivera**
Mayor Silvestrini made a motion to approve the CJAC minutes from the June 2024 meeting. Sim Gill seconded the motion; all were in favor.
- 1:22 **Office of Homelessness & Criminal Justice Reform (OHCJR) Announcements**
The Board welcomed the new OHCJR Director, Anndrea Wild. Anndrea introduced herself, her previous experience in the criminal justice system, and expressed her excitement to join the office and CJAC Board.

Alex Allen welcomed our two new CJAC Board Members Chief Brown as our Municipal Law Enforcement Representative & LEADS Representative; and Wendy Isom to serve as the victim advocate representative.
- 04:54 **Civil Commitment Update**
Alex Allen gave an update from the previous panel discussion on civil commitment. There was a request during the June 12th CJAC meeting for a write up on the civil commitment process to better inform the group. The handout was shared in person and the link was given to those online. A link to the handouts will be shared post meeting.
- 06:46 **Human Services, Criminal Justice and Homelessness Plan**
Mayor Wilson shared that Salt Lake County Bond initiative was passed with the public's consideration, and an 8/1 bipartisan vote with the SLCo Council. This initiative was to build the Justice and Accountability Center (The JAC), as well as funding expansion of housing, enforcement and criminal justice reform, address systemic gaps, expand and improve county jail mental health access, and support the DEA task force.
Discussion occurred around the room about the plan structure, benefits of this plan, and how it will address the gaps in services and recidivism rates.
- 38:43 **Justice Court Reform**
Sheriff Rivera and Alex Allen introduced Michael Drechsel, Jim Peters, and Kim Zimmerman who came to CJAC to discuss Justice Court reform and help inform the conversation. Justice Court Reform has been a topic of discussion with legislators prior to 2019. In 2019 research was conducted on the current system and resulted in 26 recommendations to improve the system.
