00:00	Welcome from Chair and Councilmember Jim Bradley Sherrif Rivera made a motion to approve the minutes from the August CJAC meeting, Councilmember Jim Bradley seconded the motion. Minutes were approved.
00:00	Welcoming New CJAC Staff Alexandra Allen was introduced as acting director of the Office of Homelessness and Criminal Justice Reform.
00:00	CJAC SB 179 Report Director Alexandra Allen discussed the CJAC SB 179 Report, due date is November 13 th 2023. Questions and discussion about the best strategy to complete report were made. The need for group review was brought up, an email will be sent for additional feed back.
08:31	HMHI Receiving Center Presentation Kevin Curits with the University of Utah presented on the Huntsman Receiving Center. The goal for 2025 will be to expand to 30 receiving chairs. Reviewed the intercept model and how diversion can play a role in the clients success. Questions were answered around the room and online.
54:47	Pretrial and Jail Release Judge McCullah gave an overview of the current status and processes of pretrial services. Discussed officer statement, Public Safety Assessment (PSA - giving a score of recommitting and a score of likelihood they will appear in court), and how info is given to the courts. Judges must set pretrial release conditions. Questions from Mayor Wilson were answered by Judge McCullah and Kele Griffone. Additional information was provided by Judge Scott and Chief Dumont.
