Mayor Wilson discussed the plans moving forward with the SLCo Jail and Justice and Accountability Center (JAC). SLCo will begin reviewing differed maintenance needs and capital assessment. Will also review other funding sources that may help support the plans outlined in the Jail bond, as well as other system needs including housing and workforce development.
